Meeting Minutes - 6:30 pm on April 17, 2018

Principal's Report: Mr. Dixon

Student Support Center Update: We are in the process of offering a candidate the position of Social Worker.

LAX: We do not currently have the data to support the effectiveness of the program. Although we feel the program is beneficial, we do need to collect data on its effectiveness. How LAX aides are funded is another issue that will have to be addressed. Aides are employed through the district and have been moving up on the pay schedule. The PTG caps their funding at \$40,000 and the school has been supplementing the remainder of the salary. Funding for aides is limited and the current structure does not support advancement on the pay schedule. Based upon the financial realities, we may need to look at restructuring this model as we move forward. Mr. Dixon will be working with staff on ways to improve the LAX program.

Testing: Testing is coming up. A letter will be sent home on how students can prepare to do their best on the exams.
