

# David Lubin PTG Meeting Minutes

September 18, 2018

## Welcome and Introductions:

Sarah Phillips introduced the board members.

## Principal's Report (Mr. Dixon):

Mr. Dixon reviewed 2018 CAASP scores.

- 55% of our students met or exceed standards in ELA. This is a 1-point increase over last year and 10% above district scores. African American students and English Language Learners are still achieving below other students at our school.
- 50% of our students met or exceeded standards in Math. This is a 2-point decrease from last year. The district scores were 32%. African American students again achieved below other students at our school.
- We have achievement disparities based upon race at our school. This is a trend over the last three years as our data has remained flat.

Mr. Dixon shared research by John Hattie and Visible Learning.

- All influences work - some better than others.
- As a staff, we are focusing on those influences that have the greatest impact.
- Collective teacher efficacy has a large influence on student achievement and we are working as a staff to develop our teacher efficacy.

Mr. Dixon indicated that his goal is to create an environment where every student makes progress.
