**Principal's Report:** Mr. Dixon

- Return to in-person learning
  - Return to school planning could not begin until Governor's standards are met for the County of Sacramento.
  - Seems like Sacramento City Unified School District is still quite a long way from return to school planning.

**Musical Theater:** Heather Downey

- Have previously and continue to partner with Sacramento Theater Company (STC).
- STC received a grant, to be used at David Lubin.
- Twice weekly (45-minute) after-school acting classes with professional teaching artists
  - Produce a piece of performance art at the end of the program
  - Theme: Dealing with COVID and distance learning
  - 1-3 grade and 4-6 grade class.
  - Will work with Aces for a central zoom link

- Free and Reduced Lunch Applications – due 10/31

## MINUTES

- The District calculates eligibility for schools using 50%+ criteria. If more than 50% of students qualify for free/reduced lunch (Title 1), the school qualifies. If 49% of students qualify, school does not qualify.
- David Lubin has historically generated data to reflect that 46% - 53% of students qualify for Title 1.
- Principal Dixon has been discussing this calculation formula with the District Superintendent to have more predictability in future years for David Lubin students.
- Volunteer Opportunities
  - Charleston Wrap annual fundraiser – looking for a liaison for next year
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday
    - Old Spaghetti Factory last week. Earned \$98.
    - Need a vendor for November 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday. Erin Powers is the liaison but is looking for help securing a vendor in November.

  - Tower theater – varies quite a bit. Need a date and movie to even get prices. Probably too late to coordinate this year.
  - Doesn't seem like it will work this year. Perhaps PTG can still help coordinate a costume contest.
- Scholastic Book Fair – October 19 – November 2
- Gift Wrap – raised \$2500. Lower than other years, but this is hard year! Everything helps.
