Kenojuak Ashevak (1927 - 2013)

Born at Ikirisaq, on the southern coast of Baffin Island, Kenojuak Ashevak was a pioneering artist whose work bridged Inuit and Western cultures. She received widespread recognition and awards for her work, which has been shown at the National Gallery of Canada.

Ashevak's drawing, The Enchanted Owl (1960), was featured on a Canada Post stamp.

A Pioneering graphic artist, printmaker and sculptor her works connect to both Inuit and Western cultures. Her print The Enchanted Owl was featured on a Canadian postage stamp.
