### **Kenojuak Ashevak (1927 – 2013)**

Born at Ikirisaq, on the southern coast of Baffin Island, Kenojuak Ashevak was a pioneering artist whose work bridged Inuit and Western cultures. She received widespread recognition and awards for her work, which has been shown at the National Gallery of Canada.

Ashevak's drawing, *The Enchanted Owl* (1960), was featured on a Canada Post stamp.

A Pioneering graphic artist, printmaker and sculptor her works connect to both Inuit and Western cultures.  
Her print *The Enchanted Owl* was featured on a Canadian postage stamp.
