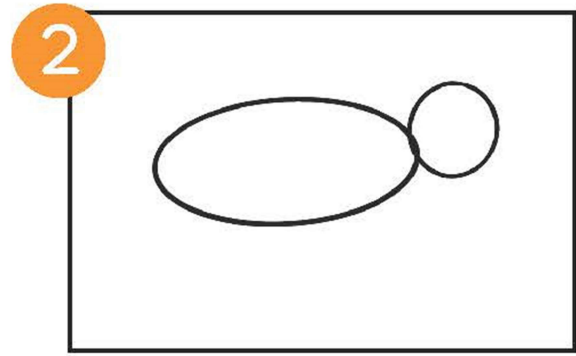
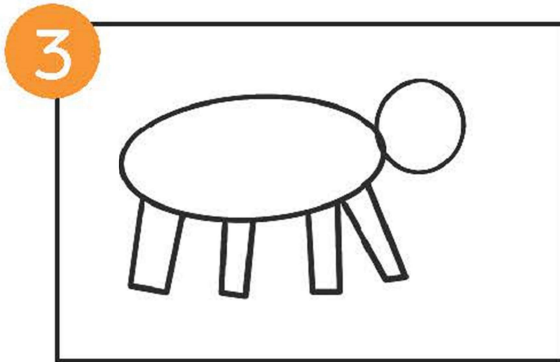


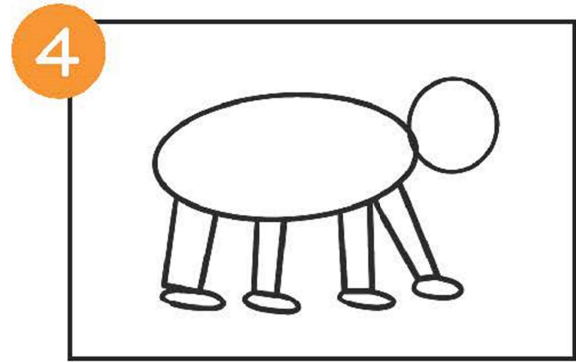
1 Draw or trace a circle near the top right corner of the paper.



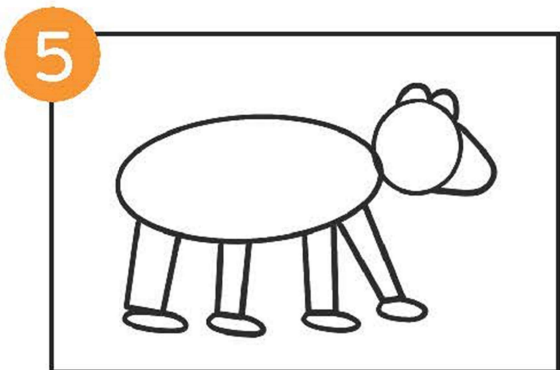
2 Draw a long oval that extends almost to the left side of the paper. Leave plenty of room above and below the oval.



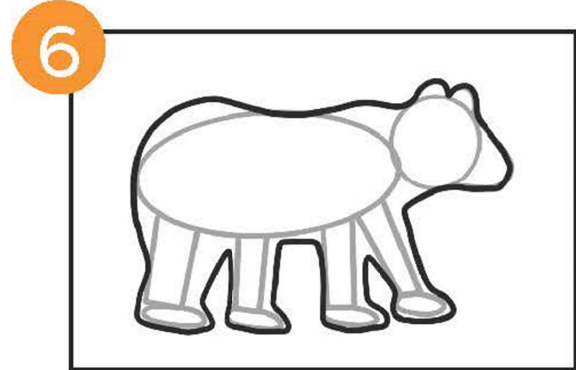
3 Add four rectangular legs; two in the front and two in the back. The front two legs should angle forward slightly.



4 Draw a thin oval at the bottom of each leg. Extend the ovals over the front of the rectangle for feet.



5 Add a muzzle that tapers off slightly on the right side of the face. Add two upside down "U" shapes for ears.



6 Draw a contour line around the outside of the shapes for the body to add volume to the bear; leaving extra room on the back and belly.
