### Fundraiser and Campus Updates

- Music Program
  - See handout from Chris Froh for programs and costing on following pages
  - Recommendation from Chris is to develop a 10-week pilot program for this year before committing to any long-term programs for next year. He will look for a music education teacher for 95 hours of instruction for K-4 and DHH for \$5,700. He will look into 5 classrooms of CLARA for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> for \$10,000.
  - Kit Adsetts moved to increase the music program budget from \$7,500 to \$16,000. Chris Froh seconded. Motion passed with unanimous voice vote.

- Grant writing and requests for donations
  - The PTG will reach out to see if we have a parent who has experience with writing to grants to develop a template for use in requesting grants for music and other programs.

**IN-CLASS INSTRUCTIONAL OPPORTUNITIES**

Title	Cost	Grade Level	Duration	Description
General Music Educator	\$40-\$60/hour	K-4	Ongoing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Curriculum may include matching pitch, learning songs, applying movement, rhythmic games, rhythmic entrainment</li> <li>- The general education model is the most common approach to primary music education</li> </ul>
Teaching Artist Residency	\$3,500/module (1 program)  \$2,500/module (2-4 programs)  \$2,000/module (5 or more programs)	4-6	10-weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Available fee-for-service through the E. Claire Raley Studios for the Performing Arts (CLARA) as 10-week residencies</li> <li>- Curricular options include: <b>African Drumming, DIY Instrument-making, and Ukulele</b></li> <li>- Residencies also include a final performance and full curricular integration.</li> </ul>
Link Up!	Free	3-5	Ongoing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Classroom teachers work with assistants from the Music Education program at CSU Sacramento to teach recorder (“song flute”) in their classroom</li> <li>- Requires active participation of classroom teacher, integration with national/international programming</li> <li>- Link Up! was created in partnership with Carnegie Hall and is presented through the Sacramento Philharmonic</li> </ul>

Title	Cost	Grade Level	Duration	Description
Mandarins Music Academy	[NEED]	5-6		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Instrumental (concert band) program for older kids</li> <li>- Includes instrumental instruction and ensemble performance</li> </ul>
Sacramento Theater Company	\$50-\$100/student  (also often subsidized by STC grants)	1-6	16 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Children’s musical theater program culminating in a public performance</li> <li>- 50-60 kids</li> <li>- Fold into Garden Tour?</li> </ul>
Samba Percussion	Free	5-6	8-weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Samba drumming led by Chris Froh</li> <li>- This would be a new offering that Chris REALLY wants to teach!</li> <li>- Could culminate in a final performance</li> </ul>

Any Given Child	Free	K-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Program of the Office of Arts and Culture</li> <li>- Wide range of Artist Residents present on-campus assemblies</li> <li>- Programming is currently on hold, but will hopefully begin again in the spring</li> <li>- Arranged with SCUSD Visual and Performing Arts Coordinator</li> </ul>
Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts	\$10/student \$12/adult + transportation (est. \$450-\$600)	K-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Matinee program offering low-cost tickets for elementary schools to attend daytime performances of visiting artists (typically symphony orchestras)</li> </ul>

## POSSIBLE COMBINATIONS

### Pilot Program A

A 10-week pilot program would give us a diagnostic view of several menu items for review before AY 22-23. Target: Spring 2022.

Title	Grade Level	Frequency	Rate	Volume	Expense
General Music Educator	K-4, DHH	1x/week, 30-minute lessons	\$60/hour	19 classrooms (95 hours of instruction)	\$5,700
CLARA Artist Residencies	5-6	1x/week, 45-minute lessons	\$2,000/residency	5 classrooms	\$10,000
<b>TOTAL COST</b>					<b>\$15,700</b>

In addition to in-class instruction, we could also offer additional student enrichment through:

- Any Given Child Assemblies
  - Target: one assembly for Spring 2022
- DLASA activities
  - Mandarins Music Academy
  - Sacramento Theater Company
  - Samba Percussion

Hiring a General Music Educator will allow us to assess their particular skills/interests over a 10-week pilot. An ideal candidate would be capable of teaching grade level-specific curriculum beginning in the fall.
