Run for Rhett Presentation

Charsey Porse, new parent to David Lubin, presented information regarding the Run for Rhett program. It's a non-profit set up by Rhett's parents who died of cystic fibrosis. This arm of the foundation provides grants to schools for a running program. With the grant the program and 5K are free of charge to all participants. It is co-ed and open to all grades 1st to 6th. They do a fall and spring session, but it is too late for Fall. Grant applications are due in February (best guess based on 5K in late April). It is a 6 week program and practice would most likely be on the field. This program will compete with Girls on the Run spring program, which is 3rd-5th grade girls. GOTR is a paid program with scholarships available.
