Principal's Report

Mr. Dixon's update

CAASPP results (an assessment test 4th 5th 6th graders take in language and math) was up 6 points from last year which represents significant gains after the losses incurred during COVID. School has initiated individualized instruction, "WIN cycles" and have hired instructional aids to continue to further improve gains. Continued reading instruction support.

President's Report

- SIPPS - Teachers have found these resources helpful for designing and implementing small group instruction
- Instructional Aides- 3 of 4 positions have been filled so far, with the 4th shortly on the way
